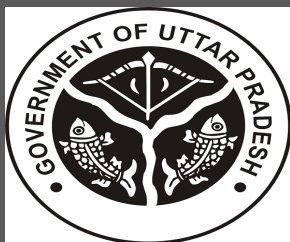

ABOUT CCS UNIVERSITY



Ch. Charan Singh University (CCSU) was established in 1965, under U.P. Universities Act 1965, as Meerut University to cater to the needs of higher education in western Uttar Pradesh. It was later renamed as Chaudhary Charan Singh University in the name of former Prime Minister of India, Ch. Charan Singh. Since its inception, the vision of the CCSU has been to be an institute to produce such professionals who have global competence, vision, and skills as are necessary to meet the challenges of emerging global knowledge economy, by the power of innovation, creativity and efficient learning ability. It is committed to promote and protect dignity, equality, social justice and human rights for all sections of the society.

It was the first University in the country to introduce M. Phil. programme. In the University campus there are several regular and self-financed graduate, post-graduate and Ph.D. programs in the faculty of Science, Arts, Law, Commerce and Business Administration, and Agriculture. The University has a separate engineering college named Sir Chhotu Ram Institute of Engineering and Technology (SCRIET) which offers courses like B. Tech. in different branches of engineering, BBA, MBA, MBA (Hospital Management), Integrated MBA (Hospital Management) and MCA.

Historical evidences predict that the city Meerut may have derived its name from 'Mayarashtra', the capital of the kingdom of Mayasura, Mandodari's father and Ravana's father-in-law. Meerut is the city that bears testimony to the great rebellion of 1857, the first war of independence. It is an ancient city located 56 km north-east of New Delhi. Meerut also has one of the biggest army garrisons / cantonments in this part of the country. It is famous for its scissors, sports goods and Gazak. Meerut is also the sports capital of India. Meerut is the capital of Pandavas in Mahabharata known as Hastinapur. The city boasts of some very important historical as well as cultural heritage sites like Meerut are Agharnath temple, Shaheed Smarak, Gandhi Bagh, Suraj kund, Shri Shantinath Digamber Jain Temple, Vidura Ka Tila, Draupadi Ki Rasoi, St John's church, Barnawa, Dogra temple, Pura Mahadev Temple. Situated very close to New Delhi, the major tourist attraction in Delhi includes the Humayun's Tomb, India Gate, Raj Ghat, the majestic Red Fort, the historical Lotus Temple and Shanti Vana. The temperature during February ranges approximately 18 degrees Celsius to 25 degrees Celsius.
