About the Research Methodology Course (RMC)

Indian higher education institutions are facing crucial challenges in creating, nurturing and maintaining the level of high quality research especially in the area of social sciences. The general connotation is that researchers cannot produce high quality research without having exposure to the latest research tools and techniques, and understanding ethical issues in carrying out research on socio-economic issues. A good research methodology is a key to scientific research output and programme evaluations. Moreover, a considerable strand remain unenlightened of the current advancement in social science research that truly makes research an activity of solving problems, and adds new dimensions, syntheses and generalizations largely derived from empirical evidences. The need of the hour is to develop a sound methodological understanding of research among the young researchers to cope with the methodological challenges. To accomplish this vision, there is need to train, reorient and motivate the research scholars in the social science disciplines. So, a Ten-days Research Methodology Course (RMC) is designed in a way that it would significantly improve the skills of research scholars and potentially help them in data collection, management and analyzes, and interpreting both qualitative and quantitative data.

The objectives of Ten Days Research Methodology Course (RMC) are to provide training to the M.Phil/Ph.D./PDF research scholars in Social Sciences and enhancing their skills of different research designs, data collection and analysis, data visualization, and interpretation of results. A hands-on training on the MS-Excel, SPSS, STATA, and Arc GIS software for their data analysis will be a part of RMC. The participants will also train on research proposal, project report and manuscript writing, handling plagiarism and indentifying good journals for publication. They will get exposure to different e-library/e-databases sources. Overall, this RMC will develop their potential as future academicians/social science researchers and expand their employability.

Number of Intake: 30 research scholars

Eligibility Criteria for Participants

Research scholars who are currently pursuing M.Phil/ Ph.D/ PDF in any social science disciplines from a UGC recognized Indian University/Deemed University/ College/ Institute of National importance/ ICSSR Research Institutes are eligible to apply for the course.

Selection of Participants

The total number of seats in RMC is limited to 30, and among them ten (10) will be from local (Meerut), ten (10) from within the state (Uttar Pradesh) and ten (10) from other states of India.

Registration Fee: There will be no registration fee.

Accommodation & Travel Allowance

Accommodation will be provided to all the outstation participants and will be accommodated in the University Hostels & Guest House. Travel allowance (bus or train fare, sleeper class only) will be reimbursed to the outstation participants.

Duration & Venue of the Workshop on RMC

The Workshop on RMC will be conducted from October 10, 2022 to October 19, 2022 at the Department of Economic, Chaudhary Charan Singh University, Meerut (UP) - 250004, INDIA.

How to Apply

Interested candidates may apply to Course Director by filling up the registration form given at the end of this leaflet. The application should reach to course director on or before September 25, 2022. The duly filled registration form should be forwarded by the head/supervisor along with required documents (Brief CV of the applicant, copy of admission/ registration letter of M.Phil/ Ph.D/PDF, caste/community certificate and one page write-up on research topic), and should be sent through email <rmccsu@gmail.com>. 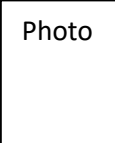
