INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

(For Assistant Professor Recruitment Test)

1. The test will be conducted online at given centre.
2. The candidate must check all the information and entries in his / her Admit Card as soon as he/she receives it.
3. NO REQUEST FOR CHANGE IN THE EXAMINATION CENTRE/CITY WILL BE CONSIDERED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.
4. The candidates must carry this Admit Card to the Examination centre and entry to the centre will be denied in the absence of the Admit Card. The candidate is also required to carry an original Government Issued Identity Card (Voter Identity Card, Driving License, PAN (Permanent Account Number) Card, Passport or Aadhaar Card etc.)
5. Candidates will not be allowed to enter the examination centre after the Gate Closing Time.
6. Candidates must abide by the instructions given by the Centre Superintendent and the Invigilators during the Examination.
7. Any candidate found indulging in unfair means/practices and / or impersonation shall be expelled from the Examination Hall and their candidature will be rejected. Legal action will also be initiated against the candidate.
8. Candidates are not allowed to carry Calculator / Slide Rule / Log Table / Graph Paper / Charts / Instruments Box or any electronic gadget e.g. Bluetooth, Mobile Phone, ATM Card, Watch etc. into the Examination Centre.
9. Each Candidate must sign above in the specified place of their Admit Card in the Examination Hall in the presence of the Invigilator.
10. This admit card should be handed over to the Invigilator as proof of Attendance for further processing of your application.
11. Candidates must appear for the examination wearing a Mask and no other relatives/guardians will be allowed entry into the Examination premises. Admission to the Examination Centre will be denied in case a candidate is not wearing a mask.
12. Candidates are allowed to carry only their Admit Card, Govt. Issued ID proof, a Sanitizer bottle and a 500ml water bottle into the Examination Centre. Bags etc. will not be allowed inside the premises and the organizers will not be responsible for the safeguarding of the students' personal assets.
13. The Online Examination shall consist of multiple-choice objective questions of 1 hour duration.
14. Candidates will not be permitted to leave the Examination Centre before the scheduled end of the examination.
15. The examination centre is under CCTV surveillance and all candidate actions are being recorded. Candidates should refrain from resorting to any unfair means or indulging in any unfair examination practices.
16. On completion of the examination, please wait for instructions from the Invigilator and do not leave your seat until advised to do so. Candidates will be permitted to leave the Examination lab one at a time only.
17. All candidates are required to download and carefully read the Instructions and Advisory for COVID-19 given with the Admit Card and strictly adhere to them.
18. Candidates are suggested to visit the examination centre, a day in advance to see the location of the centre, so that they do not face any problem on the day of examination.
19. Important Instruction for candidates on COVID-19.
 - a: Candidates must maintain social distancing starting from the point of entry in the exam venue till his / her exit.

b: Candidates must bring their own mask, personal hand sanitizer (50 ml), transparent water bottles(500ml).

c: Entry of candidates will be given as per details in the Admit Card (1.5 hours before start of examination) to maintain social distancing at the centre.

d: Candidates need to follow directions given by the personnel involved in Exam Conduct at the Examination centre from time to time.

1. The test is for a total duration of 60 minutes (1 hour).
2. The Test Timer starts once you have read the instructions and click on NEXT.
3. All questions are Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ) and there is only one correct answer for each question.
4. Question paper will be in English only.
5. All questions are compulsory. For each question, four answer options would be provided out of which only one answer is correct. Each question carries 1 mark while 1/4 mark will be deducted for a wrong answer, no mark will be deducted for a question not attempted.
6. You can mark the questions to review later by clicking on the option "FLAG FOR REVIEW"
7. You can submit your test once you have completed it by clicking on the "END TEST" button. The "END TEST" button will be visible in the "Last Question".
8. Please note that the system will automatically submit your test on the completion of the test duration of 60 minutes (1 Hour).
9. Please avoid clicking on the END TEST button before completing your test. On doing so from your end, the system will assume that the test has been completed and it will submit your test.
