

## Professor Rajendra Kumar Pandey



Dr. Rajendra Kumar Pandey is Professor in the Department of Political Science, Chaudhary Charan Singh University, Meerut, Uttar Pradesh, India. Besides earning his Master's, M. Phil. and Doctorate degrees from the University of Delhi, he also holds the prestigious Post Graduate Diploma (with *summa cum laude*: excellent grade) in Federalism, Decentralization and Conflict Resolution from the Institute of Federalism, University of Fribourg, Switzerland. For more than eighteen years, Dr. Pandey taught graduate students at two prestigious colleges of Delhi University – Delhi College of Arts and Commerce (1998-2003) and Hindu College (2003-2009), and post graduate students at UGC-Centre for Federal Studies, Jamia Hamdard University, New Delhi (2009-2018).
