

Action: All programmes have been revised under New Education Policy-2020 and the large number of new courses has been added in the revised curriculum, which are directly related skill enhancement.

Feedback- 2: Students should be given choices for course selection inter and intra-faculties.

- Action: Almost all curriculums have been developed/ enriched as per NEP-2020 guidelines, which have huge inter and intra faculty choices to provide larger academic flexibility.
- **Feedback- 3:** Feedback suggested that use of Information and communication technology (ICTs) should be enhanced in teaching.
- Action: On the basis of student feedback, most of the class/ lecture rooms across all the departments have been upgraded with ICTs facilities.

- Action: Library has increased the no of licensees of e-resources. Other research related facilities have also been significantly enhanced.
