

STUDENT'S FEEDBACK AND ACTION TAKEN REPORT-2018

On the basis of Student's feedback, the following appropriate action were taken:

Feedback-1: Curriculum required more flexibility and diversity among the courses offered by the University across all programmes.







3. HAVE YOU LEARNT ANY NEW SKILLS IN THE DUE COURSE OF YOUR STUDY?






2. WAS THE COURSE CURRICULUM FULFILLING YOUR EXPECTATIONS?




4. Did the syllabus create interest to pursue research in a particular topic?



6. ARE YOU WILLING TO CONTRIBUTE TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE DEPARTMENT / UNIVERSITY?




